








Number of undergraduate majors in department/program






Typical startup package for wet laboratory nutrition faculty hires (Assistant Professor level)




Typical startup package for dry laboratory nutrition faculty hires (Assistant Professor level)

Percentage of doctoral students in the program receiving institutional financial support from fellowships, teaching assistantships, or research assistantships, in an average year







Nutrition program has ~200 undergraduate students and about 12 graduate students. Faculty are well funded via NIH, USDA, Gates Foundation and NASA among other private agencies.

Enrollment in our DPD undergraduate program has been dropping since the MS required-RD was announced. There is general concern that students do not see a 4-year degree + MS/DI as cost-effective and are opting for nursing, kinesiology, or other health careers over dietetics.

Nutrition is fragmented at OSU and has become more so over past 15 years. Weakens our ability to negotiate for tenure track faculty and get students. Also, reduces our visibility as a strong program within the university
